# PARA-SKI WORLDCUP SERIES – GENERAL RULES

<b>Organizers/Places</b>	Information is available on <a href="http://www.paraski.org">www.paraski.org</a>									
<b>Schedule</b>	<p>Friday: 10:00 a.m. Registration closing on site, followed by Team Leader meeting and start of competition normally with skiing event first - (CR paragraph 4.5 applies with CJ approval). ,There is no participation if showing up after closing time.</p> <p>Saturday: Competition</p> <p>Sunday: 16:00 Competition End (last take off)</p> <p>Any deviation from the schedule above (e.g. change of time) needs to be indicated in the bulletin 1.</p>									
<b>Rules</b>	The current <a href="#">IPC Competition Rules for Para-Ski</a> including Annex 2 will be applied. The competitions shall be registered as FAI Second Category Events by the organizer's NAC. Date needs to be reported to FAI Office not later than 30 days in advance (see Sporting Code General Section 3.5).

<b>Giant Slalom (GS)</b>	Starting Order: see IPC CR paragraph 5.2.2.2. All Paraski World Cup Series and WPC results of the running season and the year before will be used.									
<b>Rankings</b>	<p>Individual: Combi MALE Combi FEMALE Combi JUNIOR – age less or equal 24 Combi MASTER – age greater or equal 50</p> <p>No minimum number required. No boarder rankings. Nevertheless, it is allowed to use a snowboard instead of skies.</p> <p>Team: Combi TEAM - a mix of male and female competitors, no separate female teams</p>									

<b>Awards &amp; Prizes</b>	The way of awarding the winners, or offering any prize money, is left to the organizer's solely decision.
<b>Entry Fee</b>	Individual: EUR 240 Junior: EUR 200 Jumps not made are refunded EUR 18 per jump
<b>Entry Fee includes</b>	6 Jumps + Re-Jumps Ticket for the Skilift 1 Dinner + 1 Drink Organisation Fee
<b>Remarks</b>	A registration done online or by email is provisional and does not replace the official, personal registration before 10:00 a.m. on registration day.

- A total ranking is done if a minimum of two single competitions has successfully been performed.
- To get counted for the Trophy „WCS-TOTAL“ a team must always use the same Team Name on each competition! There is no restriction on changing the team members.
- Points are awarded after the tie-break rule of IPC CR 4.4.5. or 4.4.7. has been applied.
- On equal total points, the number of participated competitions is counted, where a point ranking was reached, thereafter the better single ranking in one competition applies.
- Per winter season up to four (4) competitions are held. The appointment is done by the "Para-ski-WCS Organiser Group"
- Challenge Trophies male/ female eagle will be handed over to next winner regardless how often a champion has won it.
